INTRODUCTION

We have come to the close of an intentional spiritual learning experience.

In the introduction to the first questionnaire, I asked for your assistance in completing my dissertation project. I wrote:

The dissertation will be called *Cultivating a God-Generated Life: Living with Christ in* God through the Holy Spirit. Sometime during the past five-year period, a transition took place in my life. I began to understand and experience in a way I had never understood and experienced before what Jesus meant when He said, "I am the vine; you are the branches. If a man remains in me and I in him, he will bear much fruit; apart from me you can do nothing" (John 15:5). In addition, texts like, "I have been crucified with Christ and I no longer live, but Christ lives in me. The life I live in the body, I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me" (Galatians 2:20), "For you have died, and your life is now hidden with Christ in God" (Colossians 3:3), "To them God has chosen to make known among the Gentiles the glorious riches of this mystery, which is Christ in you, the hope of glory" (Colossians 1:27) and "But he who unites himself with the Lord is one with him in spirit" (1 Corinthians 6:17) took on new meaning for me. Moreover, I noticed that the more I lived with Christ in God through the Holy Spirit by being receptive to God's love in Christ, the more He was working out his life in and through me. The fruit of the Spirit began to manifest themselves in my life as never before. My relationship with my wife and children became more Christlike. I focused less on doing and more on being that leads to doing, experiencing a tremendous rest in my soul. I drew the conclusion that I was now living with Christ in God in a way that I had never known or experienced before.

Reading through some of the books that have appeared recently, I noticed that I was not alone in my experience. People like Dallas Willard and Larry Crabb has written about a similar experience.

What is your experience? In order to find out, I invite you to fill out the questionnaire. The questions can be answered either with a yes, a no or a sometimes. I have tried to address not just one aspect of a person, but the whole person. Thus, the first question is an affective question focusing on your feelings. The second is a cognitive one focusing on your thinking. The third question is a volitional question focusing on your will. The fourth question is a behavioral one focusing on your conduct. The questions are in groups of four. This means that each set of four questions is investigating how you feel, think, desire and act with regard to each of the 10 topics to be introduced and discussed in the 10-week learning experience you are about to embark on. You have four options. (1) Y = yes (2) N = no (3) S = sometimes or somewhat (4) U = unsure.

I would invite you to once again fill out this slightly modified form of the first questionnaire. Your answers will help me evaluate the effects of a 10-week spiritual learning experience to equip (young) adults to learn to live with Christ in God through the Holy Spirit. The options are the same as the first

questionnaire: (1) Y = yes (2) N = no (3) S = sometimes or somewhat (4) <math>U = unsure. In addition to putting a mark in the circles, I would encourage you to write feedback that you think is useful in the comment boxes provided. There is one comment box for each set of four questions. Comment box 1 pertains to lesson 1; comment box 2 to lesson 2, etc. In early 2007, I will send you a copy of the final chapter of my dissertation that will show the results and conclusions of the project.
